Project Summary

This £4.5m state-of-the-art refectory officially opened on 3 September 2007 by Roger Daltrey from 'The Who'. The new facility has a modern new-look and a wide variety of fine dining. The refectory includes a 'grab and go' service as well as offering a range of meals and snacks. The project was part phased whilst occupied. There were asbestos issues to overcome throughout and evening work was also difficult due to on going concerts which averaged over 5,000 students.

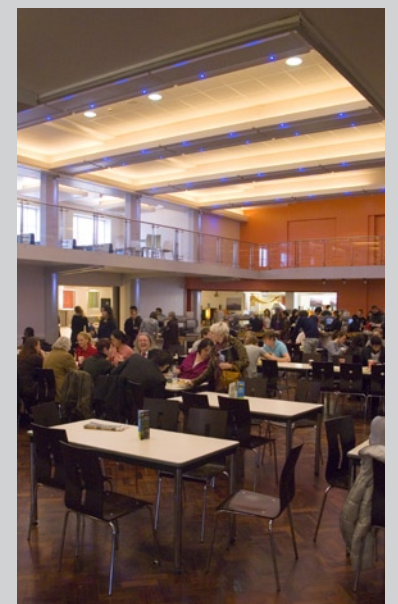
