The refurbishment of existing and provision of new Beach Chalets along Scarborough's North Bay.

### Project Summary

The overall project consisted of a large 55 acre mixed use development including retail units, bars and restaurants, health club, hotel, casino, multi-screen cinema, pool, multi-storey car park and residential units for private sale and holiday letting.

The new 55 acre development is set within the stunning North Bay, Scarborough, surrounded by high quality woodlands and landscaped parkland and overlooks the 'blue flag' beach. The scheme comprises high quality homes and holiday letting apartments within a superb leisure environment.

The aim of the Sands development was to provide Scarborough with a prime visitor attraction but more importantly, also brings investment and employment opportunities and leisure facilities for local people. It is a huge long term project and the aim was to develop in stages.
