Project Summary

The project involved the demolition and decommissioning of the existing and run down portacabin used to house District Nurses. The external area and landscaping was made good and new fire escapes and disabled ramps were installed. Internally, some existing rooms were remodelled and converted to office accommodation, including new mechanical and electrical services. The project was carried out over a short period of time and whilst the building remained fully operational.
